Our safety reps will not be alone. There is training, support, time and resources to help them.

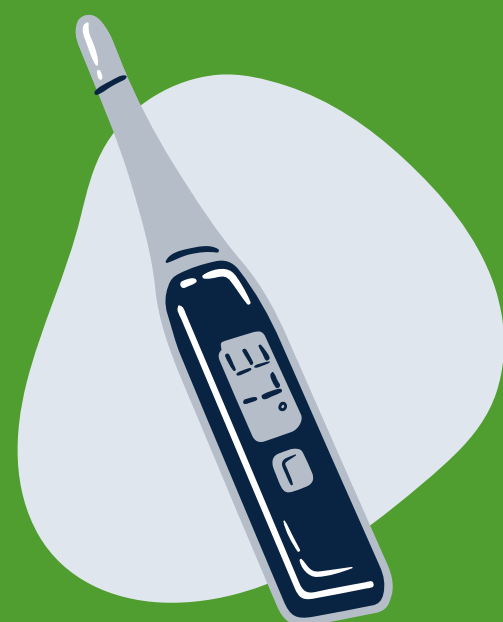
Interested? Contact your branch.

Your school must:

-  Identify the hazards.
-  Identify those who might be harmed.
-  Assess how likely the harm is to occur.
-  Identify ways to avoid or reduce the risk.
-  Make changes where changes are needed.
-  Record the findings and the controls put in place.
-  Regularly review the findings with staff and their unions.

A safety rep tackles important issues:

- Social distancing rules
- Any new working arrangements
- PPE
- Reasonable adjustments
